


# SAINTS MICHAEL, GABRIEL AND RAPHAEL, ARCHANGELS

And constantly behold thy face;


They heed thy voice, they know it well,

birds of the  $\underline{air}$ , and fish \*


that make their way through the waters.

and the haughty he knows <u>from</u> afar.


Though I walk in the midst of af<u>flic</u>tion \* you give me life and <u>frus</u>trate my foes.

making peace by the blood of his cross.




